

Introduction


- Each project team acquiring Proposition 1

Approximate Timing




Projects

- Completed environmental documents.
- Required permits/agreements.
- 100% contract for non-public benefit cost share.
- Contracts for Administration of Public Benefits (CAPBs) CDFW, SWRCB, DWR.
- Commission retains discretion to revoke an MCED if the Commission determines the applicant is not making sufficient progress.




- Commissioners wanted to review CAPBs before finalized by administering agency.
- Not an approval but review and comment.
- Understanding changes in public benefit.
- Applicant will be present to answer questions.
- Public/CWC to provide comments for agency consideration.
- Occurs towards end of obtaining Prop. 1 requirements.






- Applicants submit materials.
- Staff review.





- Staff posts 79755(a) required information on website with agenda (including staff summary and recommendation).
- Applicant and CWC staff presentations.
- Administering agencies will be present to answer questions.
- Commission considers changes to public benefits and determines final award.





Project Site Visits - Considerations

- Staff is seeking direction on site visits.
- Prior Commission was interested in site visits.
- Would take place prior to the Final Award Hearing.
- Can affect Commission meeting logistics and schedule.
- Ex-parte policy act as a Commission.
- Defining purpose of visit and information Commission would like to gain.
