Draft Contracts for Administration of Public Benefits (CAPBs)

- Prop 1 requires CAPBs executed before final funding award
- CAPBs between administering agencies and applicants
- Regulations allow for agencies to bring draft CAPB to Commission prior to finalizing
- Draft CAPBs allow for preview of public benefits and contract structure

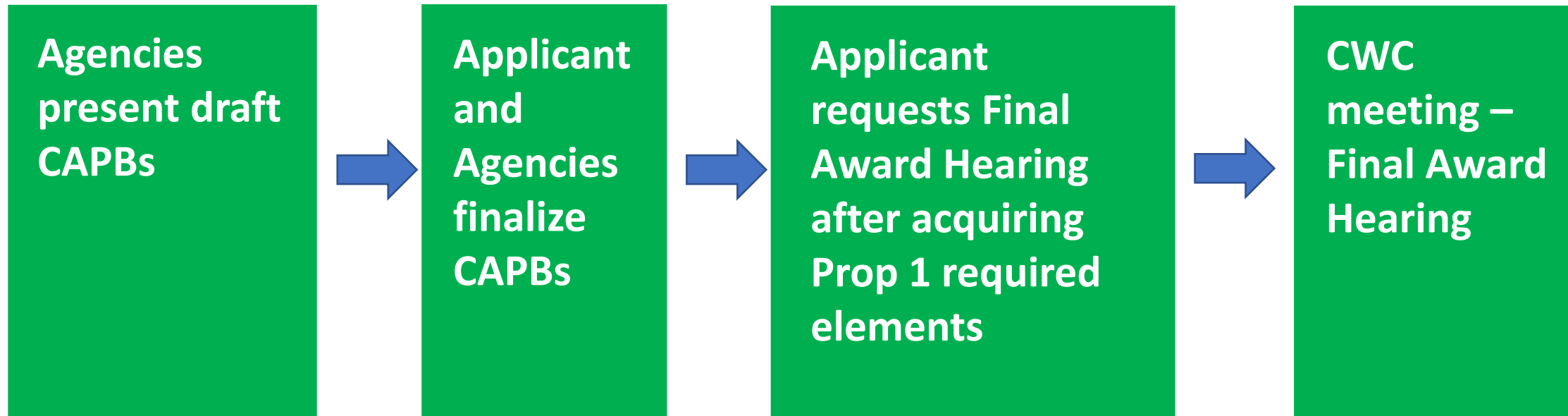
Draft CAPB Availability and Review

- Commissioners/public can provide comments
- Agencies may consider comments before executing contracts
 - Further negotiations between parties are necessary to arrive at an executed contract.
- Commission does not approve the CAPBs

Draft CAPB Availability and Review

- Draft CAPBs will be available for public review and comment for 14 days (March 8 – March 21)
- Draft CAPBs are available on CWC website
- All comments received on/before March 21 will be forwarded to the administering agencies for their consideration
