



**Informational Item:** Informational briefing on the California Roundtable on Water and Food Supply's report on Agricultural Water Stewardship

### **Background**

The California Roundtable on Water and Food Supply (CFWFS) is a forum for select leaders at the intersection of agriculture and water management to uncover obstacles, identify strategic and widely accepted solutions, and generate recommendations to assure a reliable, long-term supply of water to California's specialty crop producers while optimizing other beneficial uses of water. On June 22, the California Roundtable on Water and Food Supply released a set of recommendations to shift thinking and spur appropriate action to balance the water needs of both farms and aquatic ecosystems. Leo Winternitz, Delta Project Director for the Nature Conservancy and CFWFS member, will provide an overview of the report.
