RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE NAME RONALD B. ROBIE THERMALITO PUMPING GENERATING  
PLANT FOR A FACILITY OF THE STATE WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Water Code Section 161.5 empowers the California Water Commission to name all facilities of the State Water Resources Development System owned by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Water Resources constructed as part of the State Water Resources Development System the Thermalito Pumping-Generating plant between 1964 and 1968, part of the Oroville-Thermalito Complex, a water and power system that stores about 3.5 million acre feet of water generates power from its water releases; and

WHEREAS, Ronald B. Robie served as DWR Director from 1975-1983, led the department through a serious drought, and was instrumental in recognizing environmental forces and implementing construction measures which resulted in innovative water management and storage projects; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has considered the name "Ronald B. Robie Thermalito Pumping Generating Plant" ;


NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the California Water Commission, acting pursuant to its authority under the Water Code Section 161.5, hereby adopts the name Ronald B. Robie Thermalito Pumping Generating Plant as the official name for the aforementioned facility of the State Water Resources Development System at their meeting of September 21, 2011.
