

Proposed change to the Agricultural Water Measurement Regulation

Delete provision 597.1 (i) and add the following section to the Modified Text of Regulation dated October 19, 2011

Section 597.3 (c). An agricultural water supplier subject to the Central Valley Project Improvement Act (CVPIA) (Public Law 102-575) or the Reclamation Reform Act (RRA) of 1982 may use United States Bureau of Reclamation accuracy standards defined in Reclamation's Conservation and Efficiency Criteria Standards of 2011 to comply with this article provided all water delivered by that water supplier to each customer is measured through measurement devices that meet the 2011 accuracy standards. Documentation verifying accuracy, calibration, and maintenance of measurement devices as specified in Reclamation's Conservation and Efficiency Criteria Standards of 2011 shall be submitted in the supplier's Water Conservation Plan.
