The purpose of this email is to request a detailed explanation of the proposed Amendments contemplated. Our company has a right of way and active gas pipeline and surface facility on the Wurster property (Sacramento County APNs 132-0210-032-0000 and 132-0210-054-0000) and we are concerned that any geotechnical work on or near our gas pipeline and surface facility may create a dangerous hazard. No one from DWR has ever approached us directly regarding its plans and we have sought to get more information from California Deputy Attorney General John Feser over the last three months on this matter but he has been unable to get additional details from representatives at DWR responsive to our requests.

Today, after speaking with California Water Commission Executive Officer Sue Sims, were we ever able to get a detailed plat showing the specific location of the proposed work and its proximity to our right of way, pipeline and surface facility and we note that there appears to be an overlap of the proposed DWR work area with our pipeline and facility. All prior plats provided were so small that you could not tell where the proposed work was with respect to our affected interests.

We request that the Commission make sure that all affected interest owners be given the same detailed plat as we were provided today and that an adequate explanation and dialogue be commenced with the affected owners before the Water Commission approves any changes or actions to commence any work. We also ask that the Water Commission assure itself that proper notice requirements are followed by DWR regarding possible excavations near pipelines by contacting Underground Service Alert (USA) before it undertakes any projects in the ground.
