



Update on CALFED Surface Storage Projects

Background

In 2000, CALFED identified five potential surface storage studies for investigation. These projects included: North-of-the-Delta Offstream Storage Investigation, Upper San Joaquin River Basin Storage Investigation, Los Vaqueros Expansion Investigation, Shasta Lake Water Resources Investigation, and an In-Delta Storage Program. The investigations were formulated to meet three objectives: water supply reliability, water quality improvement, and ecosystem improvement.

In November 2010, the Department of Water Resources (DWR) presented a progress report on the CALFED Surface Storage Investigations to the California Water Commission, summarizing how changes in water management conditions had affected the investigations. At this meeting, DWR will update the commission on the status of the surface storage investigations.
