

Summary of Required Findings for a Resolution of Necessity

Previous Findings by California Water Commission:

- (1) The public interest and necessity require the proposed project.
- (2) The proposed project is planned or located in the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.
- (3) The property described in the Resolution is necessary for the proposed project.
- (4) That either the offer required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code has been made to the owner or owners of record, or the offer has not been made because the owner cannot be located with reasonable diligence.

Additional Findings Required for a Resolution of Necessity if Property Already Appropriated for a Public Use:

- (1) If the property has already been appropriated for public use, the proposed use will not unreasonably interfere with the public use as it exists. CCP 1240.510 and/or;
- (2) the proposed use is more necessary than the existing public use. CCP 1240.610.
