



Action Item: Presentation and Consideration of Comments on the Objectives and Resource Management Strategies in the California Water Plan Update 2013

Background

The California Water Plan (CWP) is published every five years and presents the status and trends of California's water supplies, water-dependent natural resources, and agricultural, urban and environmental water demands. The plan is developed through a collaborative process with federal, state, tribal, regional and local entities.

Last month, the Commission sent a general comment letter for Volume 1, The Strategic Plan.

Volume 3, released for public review in mid-October, is an evaluation of different regional and statewide resource management strategies to reduce water demand, increase water supply, reduce flood risk, improve water quality, and enhance environmental and resource stewardship. The strategies support the 17 Objectives, found in Volume 1, which reflect the water management topics of the Plan.

DWR and Commission staff will present highlights of the Plan and make recommendations for Commission consideration and comments related to specific Objectives and Resource Management Strategies.
