



Update from DWR on Organizational Changes to Support BDCP Activities

Background

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has been involved in the development of the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP) since 2006. The planning phase for the BDCP will soon be complete and DWR is preparing for the implementation phase. DWR recently established two new organizations within the Department: the BDCP Office and the Delta Conveyance Facilities Design and Construction Enterprise. The BDCP Office will focus on completion of the plan and will begin implementation of conservation measures 2 through 22. The Delta Conveyance Facility Design and Construction Enterprise (DCE) will support the design and construction of the proposed Delta Conveyance facilities.

Laura King Moon, Chief Deputy Director of DWR, will brief the Commission on these organizational and administrative changes to support BDCP planning and implementation activities.
