

Stakeholder Outreach Activities for Water Storage Investment Program

The California Water Commission provides a public forum for discussing water issues. For the development and implementation of the Water Storage Investment Program, the Commission plans to actively engage the public, stakeholders, state, federal and local agencies, and other interested organizations. All Commission meetings are open to the public. All draft and final work products, agenda items, and public comments to the Commission are available on the website and upon request.

To provide additional review, recommendations, and public input to the Commission as it develops the regulations, guidelines, project evaluation criteria, and other technical and components for the Water Storage Investment Program, a Stakeholder Advisory Group will be established.

In January 2015, Commission staff with direction from the Commission members, will develop a Charter describing the purpose and goals, participant and staff roles and responsibilities and schedule. These meetings which are expected to begin in February will be facilitated. Staff will provide the Advisory group with agendas and meeting materials, and assist with meeting the Commission's timeline for input, recommendations, and other deliverables.
