



Update on IRWM Funding

Background

Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) is an effort to identify and implement water management solutions on a regional scale in order to increase regional self-reliance and reduce conflict. IRWM is critical to responding to California's water management challenges through local and regional cooperation and investment. DWR's IRWM program provides grants and technical and facilitation services to regional water management groups. Much of the local funding distributed by DWR is allocated through the Division of IRWM, including much of the funding that has been recently dedicated to drought response, as well as funds from Proposition 84 and Proposition 1.

DWR will provide a brief overview of the current status of IRWM grant funding, including the status of the Proposition 84 2015 Implementation Grant solicitation and development of the Proposition 1 IRWM grant program concepts.
