



**Welcome and Presentation by Metropolitan Water District on Local Water Supply and Management**

**Background**

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan) is a regional water wholesaler that delivers water to 26 member agencies which provide service to more than 19 million people. Metropolitan owns and operates an extensive system of hydroelectric facilities, reservoirs, and water treatment facilities. The district imports water from several sources, including the State Water Project, to supplement local supplies. Metropolitan delivers an average of 1.7 billion gallons of water per day to a 5,200 square-mile service area.

Jeff Kightlinger, General Manager of Metropolitan, will provide the Commission with an overview of local water supply conditions and management. This is an informational item.
