



**Sustainable Groundwater Management Act Implementation: Summary of Comments on
Basin Boundary Emergency Regulation**

Background

The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act requires the Department of Water Resources (DWR) to develop emergency regulations describing the process for requesting changes to groundwater basin boundaries, as well as regulations for groundwater sustainability plans. At the August 19 meeting of the Commission, DWR provided an overview of the proposed draft basin boundary emergency regulations. The text of the draft regulations was released for public review on July 17 and comments were accepted until September 4. Additionally, DWR held a series of public meetings to collect public input on the draft regulations. At this meeting, DWR staff will provide a summary of comments received on the the draft basin boundary emergency regulations. This is an informational item.
