



Presentation on UC Water Initiative

Background

The UC Water Security and Sustainability Initiative (UC Water Initiative) was established by the University of California in 2015 to address the impacts of a changing water cycle on human and environmental uses of water. The initiative is focused on strategic research to build the knowledge base for improved water resources management. Work includes developing innovative water accounting and analysis methods and improving the understanding of the way water flows through the natural environment. Legal and policy research is integrated into findings to facilitate more integrated water management institutions. The UC Water Initiative has brought together researchers from the University of California campuses are Berkeley, Davis, Merced, Santa Cruz and San Diego.
