



**Water Storage Investment Program: Review Administrative Draft Regulations Including
Department of Fish and Wildlife's Draft Ecosystem Priorities and Relative Environmental Values
and State Water Resources Control Board's Draft Water Quality Priorities and Relative
Environmental Values**

Background

In November 2014, California voters passed [Proposition 1: the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014](#). The bond dedicated \$2.7 billion to be continuously appropriated to the California Water Commission to pay for the public benefits of water storage projects and requires the Commission to develop regulations for the quantification and management of the public benefits of water storage projects. The Commission is carrying out these responsibilities through the Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP).

At this meeting Jenny Marr, Commission Supervising Engineer and WSIP Project Manager, will present a revised staff draft of the WSIP regulations and ask for comments from the Commission. Staff intends to present revised administrative draft regulations for consideration at the Commission's November meeting. This is an informational item.
