



Sustainable Groundwater Management Act Implementation: Update on Groundwater Sustainability Plan Regulations

Background

The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act requires the Department of Water Resources (DWR) to develop and adopt emergency regulations for evaluating and implementing Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs) by June 1, 2016. DWR has established a comprehensive outreach plan in order to collect information pertinent to development of the GSP regulations. To this point, DWR has conducted scoping to collect issues, released draft discussion papers, and held public informational sessions. The Commission was last briefed on progress on the GSP regulations at its August 19 meeting. At this meeting, DWR staff will update the Commission on the development of the GSP regulations. This is an informational item.
