Re: COMMENTS ON THE PRELIMINARY WORKING DRAFT OF THE DRAFT CALIFORNIA  
CODE OF REGULATIONS TITLE 23.WATERS. DIVISION 7. CALIFORNIA WATER  
COMMISSION CHAPTER 1 WATER STORAGE INVESTMENT PROGRAM.

Dear Ms. Landis and Ms. Marr:

Plumas County appreciated the opportunity to submit verbal comments at the September 2, 2015 Stakeholder Advisory meeting. Plumas County has the following initial comment and anticipates commenting on the further development of these regulations.

**Page 6:** Section 6001. General Provisions (b) Eligibility (2):

Comment: An additional category (viii) should be added, titled "Multiple-benefit storage projects". This category is needed to capture storage projects that include one or more benefits, e.g. Benefits "i" through "vii". For example storage projects in Southern California that capture storm water and replenish aquifers in combination with aquifer remediation should be able to show integrated benefits (ii and iii). Headwater ecosystem storage projects that benefit eligible project types ii, iv, and v may demonstrate broader benefits through an integrated benefits rather than a segregated benefits approach to defining eligible project types.
