



# Water Storage Investment Program Public Meeting Calendar

The California Water Commission is hosting three public meetings in April to provide an opportunity for stakeholders and the public to learn about the Commission's Water Storage Investment Program.

In November 2014, California voters overwhelmingly approved Proposition 1, the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014, affirming the need for a safe and reliable supply of water to support the state's economy, environment, and quality of life. The bond includes \$2.7 billion for public benefits of water storage projects that improve the operation of the state water system, are cost effective, and provide measurable benefits to the Delta ecosystem or its tributaries. The California Water Commission (Commission), through the Water Storage Investment Program, will fund the public benefits of eligible water storage projects.

The public meeting will provide details on which projects are eligible for funding, the timeline for the program, and how to provide feedback on the program.
