



WSIP Technical Presentation: Framework for Quantifying Benefits

Background

The California Water Commission is developing the Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP) and regulations for the quantification and management of the public benefits of water storage projects in order to implement Chapter 8 of Proposition 1. The WSIP Quantification Regulations include quantification principles and performance standards that an applicant is required to follow in order to compete for WSIP funding. Staff is developing a Technical Reference Document that will be incorporated by reference into the draft WSIP Quantification Regulations to provide additional guidance to potential applicants on project analysis and quantification of public benefits.

At this meeting, Commission staff will provide a high-level overview of the steps WSIP applicants will take to quantify the benefits of their projects. This presentation is intended to provide the Commission and public with a more thorough understanding of the quantification process. This is an informational item.
