



Informational Briefing on DWR's Water Loss Regulations

Background

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) is developing regulations for validation of water loss audits, pursuant to Senate Bill 555. Senate Bill 555, passed in October 2015, requires all urban retail water suppliers to submit validated water loss audits to DWR annually beginning in October 2017. A water loss audit is an accounting procedure that estimates water loss that may be due to distribution system inefficiencies and leaks.

At this meeting, DWR staff will brief the Commission on the requirements of Senate Bill 555, the topics that the validated water loss regulations will address, and DWR's progress on the regulations. This is an informational item.
