Second Notice of Public Availability of Additional Documents

Water Storage Investment Program Quantification Regulations

Public Hearing Date: March 16, 2016
Public Availability Date: September 9, 2016
Deadline for Public Comment: October 3, 2016

At its August 29 public meeting, the California Water Commission directed Commission staff to move forward with the public process to notice modified text and additional documents for public comment.

The Commission directed the Executive Officer to make the modified regulatory language, and any additional conforming modifications, available for public comment, with any additional supporting documents and information, for a period of at least 15 days as required by Government Code section 11346.8.

In the Final Statement of Reasons, staff will respond to all comments received on the record during the comment periods. The Administrative Procedure Act requires that staff respond to comments received regarding all noticed changes. Therefore, staff will only address comments received during this comment period that are responsive to this notice and the document added to the record. Commenters may aggregate their comments on this notice and the First Notice of Public Availability of Modified Text and Availability of Additional Documents into a single comment.
