



**Commission Preparatory Briefing: Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP)
Scoring and Determinations**

BACKGROUND

At the Commission's August 16, 2017 meeting, staff briefed the Commission on the process and timing for evaluating applications for Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP) funding. The briefing outlined a series of presentations to prepare the Commission for its 2018 deliberations on public benefits ratios, application scores, determinations, and maximum conditional eligibility determinations. In September, staff briefed the Commission on the process for determining the Public Benefit Ratios (PBRs).

This second preparatory briefing will review the process for determining the final Expected Return for Public Investment Score. This presentation will describe the timeframe and the information the Commission will receive to determine final scores, including the component scores (PBRs, Relative Environmental Value, Resiliency, and Implementation Risk) that comprise the Expected Return for Public Investment Score. This presentation will also describe the process the Commission will use to make the determinations required by Water Code section 79755 for each WSIP project.
