



**Commission Preparatory Briefing: Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP)
Maximum Conditional Eligibility Determinations**

Background

At the Commission's August 16, 2017 meeting, Commission staff outlined a series of presentations to prepare the Commission for its 2018 deliberations on the WSIP, including Public Benefit Ratios (PBRs), component scores, determinations, and Maximum Conditional Eligibility Determinations. In September and November, staff briefed the Commission on the process for determining the PBRs, component scores, and determinations.

This final preparatory briefing will review the Commission's process for making Maximum Condition Eligibility Determinations (MCEDs). After eligible projects are scored and ranked, the Commission will determine a maximum conditional eligibility amount based on the final ranking of the project and the considerations set forth in section 6011(h) of the WSIP regulations. The maximum conditional eligibility amount is a "not to exceed" amount of potential funding, contingent upon the applicant meeting the conditions of section 6013.
