<p>Official Regulation Process*</p>	<p>2014/2015</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • October – Review/approve draft Regulation • November – Submit draft Regulation, Initial Statement of Reasons, to OAL (if bond approved) • Official 45-day public comment period, additional 15-day comment periods as needed (One-year deadline for approval of final Regulations)
